## Policy and Procedure for the Readmission of Service Members

**Policy:** Triangle Tech will readmit Service Members in alignment with the Federal Student Aid Handbook guidance published in the 2024-2025 Federal Student Aid Handbook in Volume 2 Chapter 3. A copy of this


or necessary in every instance. An institution may not delay or attempt to avoid readmission of a servicemember by demanding documentation that does not exist, or is not readily available, at the time

If the student is readmitted to the same program, for the first academic year in which they return, Triangle Tech will assess the tuition and fee charges that they were or would have been assessed for the academic year during which they left the school. However, if their veterans education benefits or other service member education benefits will pay the higher tuition and fee charges that other students in the program are paying for the year, the school may assess those charges to the student as well.

If the student is admitted to a different program, and for subsequent academic years for a student admitted to the same program, Triangle Tech will assess no more than the tuition and fee charges that other students in the program are assessed for that academic year.

The cumulative length of the absence and of all previous absences from the school for military service may not exceed five years. Only the time the student spends actually performing service is counted. See the following additional information section for more about cumulative length of absence.

A school must promptly readmit a service member with the same academic status they had when last attending the school or accepted for admission to the

#### Readmission Requirements for Servicemembers
